RESET/RESTART PLAN SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. All students **P-3** will enter via the front door and must have a face covering. Students eating breakfast should be there by 8:00. **For those not eating breakfast, they may not enter the building until 8:10. At 8:10 students will be proceeding to the classrooms or as soon as they finish their breakfast. The tardy bell rings at 8:25. This will help facilitate the social distancing requirements.**
2. Those students eating breakfast will remain in the cafeteria to eat.
3. Each grade level team will develop a restroom schedule. Only 3 boys and 3 girls will go at a time. The grade level aide will assist with the restroom routines until comfortably established. Handwashing visuals and floor directional visuals will be in place to serve as reminders to help the kids, especially with social distancing.
4. There will be no drinking from the fountains. Hands free water bottle fillers have been installed on each floor. Students will be provided with water bottles courtesy of the PTO. Please make sure his/her name is on the bottle.
5. **Students will be eating lunch in the classrooms, with teachers eating with them.** Meals will be delivered to the classrooms. Lunch will be expanded to 30 minutes for eating. Teachers will then supervise their students for recess activities.
6. Dismissal will be as follows: **PS 2:20 Group A-2:25 Group B will be 2:40. All students K-3 will be assigned to either group A or B. All siblings from a family will be assigned to the same group for safety purposes.**
Class rosters will be posted on Thursday, Aug. 20 after 3:00. There will be either a letter A or B beside your child's name to designate the dismissal group.
Bus students will remain the same. Bus students will exit the playground door.
All other students will exit the front door.
7. Cleaning supplies will be throughout the building, with maintenance staff sanitizing areas throughout the building the entire day. Heavy duty cleaning will be done daily after end of day dismissal.
8. Art and music will be in the classrooms. Physical education will be part classroom/part gymnasium. **Students will have the same special each day for the nine week term. This will help to limit the number of interactions between students and adults.**

9. Teachers will be integrating technology daily, so as to help prepare students in case we must move to remote learning.
10. **All students K-3 must wear a face covering. PS students must wear a mask when entering the bldg, in the hallways, and on the bus. Students will be provided with a lanyard to help hold on to their masks.** Plastic dividers will be placed on desks and tables as an added measure of safety.
11. Recess is still in the planning stages, as we want to ensure maximum safety for all.
12. There will be no Open House. **However, school supplies will be provided to all students the first week of school. This includes a clear bookbag.**
