The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$13,361.04, Escrow checks totaling \$180,984.87, Activity checks totaling \$22,974.98, and Student Fee checks totaling \$100.00.

The Elementary Principal was not in attendance. Mr. Alexander mentioned that the Marzano training with Jan Hoegh went well, and most teachers were done with the ELA portion. The elementary rooms are almost ready to go for the new school year. There are new cabinets being installed in the 5th grade room. More blue mulch has been ordered for the playground.

Mr. Alexander mentioned that Bloomfield would be cooping with Crofton for girls wrestling.

The Superintendent reported that we will see an increase in State Aid. He is expecting an increase in the assessed Knox and Cedar County valuations. The summer custodial employees are working at the high school building. Drywall cracks and touch up painting is being completed. Mr. Alexander is hopeful for a mid-July punch list for the new remodel/renovation. The epoxy floors have been completed. The west entry way glass and doors are being installed. Dirt work and concrete on the west side of the gym will begin soon. Lunch prices will see a slight increase for the 2022-2023 school year. Meals will not be free this year, so families are encouraged to fill out the Free/Reduced paperwork early. We received only one milk bid from Highland Dairy. Handbooks will be updated. Knife River will be in town and will be overlaying Benton Street in front of the school and will also put asphalt on the east side of the high school building.

The Board discussed the changes in the transportation employees. Kevin Millikan will be the new transportation director. Marlene Folck will continue to drive routes and activities. Roland Johnson will continue as custodial as well as substitute route driving. These changes will open up a custodial position. Lunch prices were discussed. We are hoping for no more than a .05 raise in meal prices if this is approved by the State. School fundraising was discussed. Jason Hefner would like to see a committee set up to review and approve the need for fundraising by organizations. School safety was discussed. The district will plan a practice reunification drill during the coming school year. When Board members need to visit with a faculty member they should first start with the teacher or staff member to resolve the issue before going to the Athletic Director, Principal or Superintendent. Bloomfield will join with Crofton for girls wrestling if we have any female students that would like to participate.
