The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$26,611.01, Escrow checks totaling \$185,799.29, and Activity checks totaling \$21,313.48, and Cooperative checks totaling \$5,034.89.

The Elementary Principal reported there were 65 students that participated in Miles of Smiles. Pictures, hearing, and vision screening have been completed. The Aims Web reading is showing considerable

improvement. The Elementary enrollment is 136 students. The lunch program is still in need of help. If you are interested in helping in any way, please stop by the elementary school. Homecoming is coming up next week with coronation on the 19th of Sept. and the parade will be Sept. 23rd starting at 3:00 p.m. There will be a 2:40 dismissal on Sept. 30th. Parent-teacher conferences will be held from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Oct. 5th and Oct. 12th. There will be not school on Oct. 14th.

Mr. Messersmith was at a Lewis & Clark meeting, so he was not in attendance. His report listed upcoming events. We are still waiting for software to run the Alumni display that is in the west lobby. NWEA testing is complete. Mr. Messersmith shared results with the Board.

Mr. Alexander mentioned that the State Education Conference is coming up in November. Federal applications are progressing with many having an Oct. 15th deadline. Future projects will include concreting the bus lane in the west parking lot and remodeling the old locker rooms. Students finished MAPS testing earlier in September. Bloomfield Schools will be implementing a reunification drill in October. The date is being worked out to coordinate with the police, fire, and rescue units.

There were no committee reports.

Discussion items included the State Education Conference in Omaha. The west lobby area was discussed with regards to handicap parking, handicap access and the tight parking stalls.
