Credit By Exam

Texas Administrative Code §74.24 requires districts to provide a minimum of 4 testing opportunities per calendar year for students to accelerate at no cost to the student. Students are allowed to take each test only once during the test period. The testing window must be designed to meet the needs of all students. The dates must be publicized in the community.

The quarterly testing windows designated by TAC §74.24 are

- January 1 March 31
- April 1 June 30
- July 1 September 30
- October 1 December 31

Region 7 supports districts with the credit by exam mandate by hosting testing opportunities utilizing tests from the University of Texas at Austin for grades 3 – 12. Region 7 does not offer assessment opportunities for students in grades K - 2. These Dates will be provided to campuses when released.

A battery of four (4) exams (Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies) is offered for grades 3 - 5. Students may earn credit for an academic subject in grades 6 - 12 if the stipulated requirements are met.
