School Health Info Updates Sept. 23

Due date for all required school physicals, immunizations, and vision exams is October 15, 2020. No exceptions. This is the exclusion date.

Requirements by grade level

Preschool students require:

· School physical and immunization record

Kindergarten students require:

- School physical & immunization record
- **Required immunizations**: 4th dose Dtap, 3rd dose inactivated polio, 2nd dose MMR, 2nd dose varicella.
- Recommended immunizations: Flu vaccine and 2nd hep A.
- Vision Exam completed by an eye doctor
- Dental Exam

2nd grade students require:

Dental Exam

6th grade students require:

- School physical & immunization record
- Required immunizations: dose of Tdap, 3rd dose hep B, proof of 2 doses MMR, dose of meningococcal.
- Recommended immunizations: Flu vaccine
- Dental Exam

9th grade students require:

- · School physical & immunization record
- Recommended immunizations: Flu vaccine
- Dental Exam

12th grade students require:

- · Immunization record
- Needs 2nd meningococcal immunization; if their 1st dose was before their 16th birthday.

Flu Shot: not required, however it is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for ALL GRADE LEVEL STUDENTS!

Frequently asked questions:

- My child had a physical last year, is it still good?
- ****The exam date of the school physical must be within 1YEAR of the start date of the 2020/21 school year (Aug.26,2020) Good dates: 8/26/19 through current date.
- How long is an eye exam good for?
- **** Eye exams must be done between 8/26/19 through current date.
- How long is a dental exam good for?
- **** Dental exams are due 5/5/21. Good dates: 2/15/20 through 5/15/21.

*** Please remember that a sports physical can not take place of a mandated school physical.***
