WHEN THERE IS A <u>POSITIVE</u> COVID-19 CASE IN STERLING PUBLIC SCHOOLS



Sterling Public Schools WILL:

- 1. Call families/staff who were within 6 feet for 10 or more minutes (close contacts).
- 2. Isolate the close contacts until they can be sent home to quarantine for 14 days.
- 3. Work with the family to provide continuous education, technology, and supports.
- 4. Conduct extra cleaning in the areas the infected individual spent time.
- 5. Inform the local health department.
- 6. Send an email to families that have a student in the building to inform them of the positive case.



Sterling Public Schools WILL NOT:

- 1. Provide personally identifiable information of an infected person (name, grade, level or class information) to students, staff or the community.
- 2. Immediately close schools for one positive case.
- 3. Email the entire district of the positive case or post on social media.
- 4. Notify students, staff, or the community when someone has to quarantine because they are a close contact.
