Sexual Harassment Checklist for Students

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (20 U.S.C. § 1681) is a federal law that prohibits discrimination based on the sex of students or employees in educational institutions that receive federal financial assistance. The McAllen Independent School District prohibits discrimination, including harassment, against any student/employee on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, gender, national origin, age, disability, or any other basis prohibited by law. Retaliation against anyone involved in the complaint process is a violation of District Policy and is prohibited. Please utilize this checklist to determine if the elements of sexual harassment are present under Title IX (34 CFR 106), and, if so, please complete the Title IX Referral Form.
