

## Springfield Cosmos Fall 2020 Covid-19 Spectator Policy:

- Springfield High School and Riverside Middle School will adhere to the following spectator policy for all games hosted at Brown Field, Gurney Field and Porter Field.
- A will call list for each Cosmo team of approved parents, guardians and pre-approved family members will be at each event. That list will be kept for contact tracing. There will be no staff, student body or community members in attendance to help limit crowd size. Each visiting school will be allowed two parents only, based on the roster provided by the visiting teams Athletics Director.
- Facial coverings must be worn at all times by all spectators from the time they arrive at the facility until they leave. Cloth or procedural masks are required per school policy. Gaiters and bandanas are not approved facial coverings.
- Porter and Gurney do not have bleachers so spectators who wish to sit should bring their own chairs/blankets.
- There will be no charge for admission. Each field will have cones or markings that are socially distanced. Spectators must social distance and will be asked to “find an available cone” for that purpose. Families are encouraged to stay together at their “cone zone”.
- No food will be sold or allowed into any facility with the exception of water.
- Both SHS & RMS buildings will not be open to the public. Currently at all three locations there are portable toilets that will be open to spectators.
- All spectators are required to leave the area once the game is complete. All athletes needing rides should be met in the parking lot. Nobody should be waiting on or near the field.
