



Middlebury Union High School Spectator Procedures 2020-2021

- At no time shall the total number of spectators exceed current limits on event size as established by the Governor. – **currently 150 for outdoor events.**
- Due to limits on the size of gatherings and the need for physical distancing, Middlebury Union High School will start the season by limiting game attendance to two (2) spectators per athlete and coach on the roster. The remaining tickets (**if there are any**) will be given to MUHS students. Visiting teams must only request tickets that they know will be used. The coaches' tickets are meant for spouses or children, and are not to be used by boosters or friends of the staff. Anyone attending the game will be required to have their ticket with them when they arrive. **We will not allow anyone into the facility who does not have a ticket.**
- Entry for spectators will begin 30 minutes before the posted start time of each game.
- Fans must NOT attend games if any of the following are true:
 - In the past 14 days have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
 - In the past 14 days have traveled to a location not eligible for quarantine-free travel.
 - Feel unwell with any symptoms consistent with COVID-19.
 - Have a body temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher.
- All spectators, including members of the media, must wear facial coverings and practice physical distancing. Spectators who neglect these rules will be asked to leave immediately, and attendance at future games may be jeopardized.
- Parents who bring younger children to the athletic facilities are responsible for keeping those children close at hand as their own ability to maintain proper physical distancing is limited.
- Periodic announcements will be made to remind spectators of the importance of physical distancing. **“Spectators, we all must do our part to keep each other safe. Please remember to wear your facial covering and maintain at least 6 feet of distance between yourself and members of different households.”**
- No spectators are allowed at practice sessions. If parents need to wait for their student's practice to end, they must remain in the parking lot.
- Tape will be used on bleachers and paint will be used on grass, as a guide for physical distancing.
- Spectators who leave the game facilities will NOT be readmitted and must leave the grounds immediately.
- For Fall 2020, no entry fees will be charged for any MUHS athletics events.
- MUHS will not offer concession stands at any sporting events this Fall.
- Restroom facilities will be available at all MUHS games.
- Any allowance for spectators at indoor events must be consistent with the most current health guidance published by the Agency of Education related to school visitors – currently no outside visitors and volunteers are allowed.
