Dear Parents,

I hope this email finds you well. At last night's board meeting, it was reconfirmed that we will be returning to in person instruction starting Monday, October 5th. In person instruction will occur for grades PreK-8 and hybrid learning for grades 9-12. Factors that may change this between now and October 5th would be an unusually high number of COVID cases in the seven municipalities in our district and/or a continued trend of increasing case rate numbers in La Crosse County. If that occurs, I will communicate to parents by Wednesday, September 30th that we will stay in virtual instruction for another week. I will be sending an explanation of how those decisions will be made in a subsequent email using the Bangor Municipal-Harvard Framework for school reopening/closing that was approved last night by the Board.

Regarding changes in modes of instruction (virtual, hybrid or in person) due to COVID, that decision will be made weekly on Wednesday using the framework mentioned above after consultation with our medical experts, the La Crosse County Health Department, neighboring superintendents and our administrative team. That decision will then be communicated through email and text to the staff and to our parents and families through our JMC student information system and our website. If there is a change to the mode of instruction, that will begin on the following Monday.

Thank you for your patience, understanding and support through these challenging times. It is very much appreciated. Dave
