Connecting your ChromeBook to your home WI-Fi or Hotspot

- 1) When you power your Chromebook on, you should see a screen that lists all available wireless networks. You should see the name of your home Wi-Fi or the name of your hotspot Wi-Fi
- 2) Click on your home Wi-Fi or Hotspot Wi-Fi
- 3) After entering the password, your Chromebook will connect, and you should see the regular Chromebook sign-in screen.
