Meal Service Announcements

All meals served by Marshall Public Schools will be free for all (in-seat and distance) children through age 18. Meals will be free from September 10, 2020 to the end of December 2020 or until federal grant money is exhausted. If a student has money in their account, it will remain in their account for them to use after the federal grant money ends.

Marshall Public School District is excited to announce

1. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has recently extended several flexibilities that will allow all students attending ALL schools in the Marshall Public School District to receive free meals through December 31, 2020 or until available funding runs out through the Seamless Summer Option program. MPS will serve meals free of charge to children starting 9/10/20, including teenagers through age 18, under the school meal program rules.
2. Meals will be offered to students participating in Marshall Public Schools distance learning.
3. The district will serve meals to support students on Wednesdays when all students are learning at a distance (based on phases outlined in the Returning to Learning Plan)
4. The district will serve meals to support students during times of closure due to COVID-19 (based on phases outlined in the Returning to Learning Plan)

Menu and meal planning for distance learners

- Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays will be peanut butter and jelly along with a cold breakfast unless supplies are unavailable
- Tuesdays and Thursdays will be a hot menu item for lunch and a cold breakfast
- Students can pick up breakfast and/or lunch. They do not have to get both meals.
