Dear Vikings,

As we are ready to open school for all of our in-person learners, it is more important than ever to promote social distancing and mask wearing outside of school too. Students who are coming into school, just like our teachers and staff, have an extra personal responsibility to be safe at all times. None of us love wearing masks and being less social, but it is the best way for us to stay safe.

Students have to be honest with how they are feeling and if they have any Covid symptoms, they must stay home, as well as all of their siblings. Please call us and we can walk you through the steps to return to school. It is extremely important that all of us follow DuPage's Decision Making Tree for Schools. This tells parents and schools what should be done if, and when, a student has been exposed or has symptoms. Our building and grounds team has also been doing their part to keep our buildings safe and disinfected. During the time between the AM and PM sessions, they clean every used classroom and bathroom extremely well. They are using hospital grade cleaners and we now use a disinfectant spraying machine that effectively disinfects a whole classroom in under ten minutes. IMPORTANT INFO TO REMEMBER

- It is important that the kids remember to wear their masks on the bus and that they sit in their assigned seat on the bus. Bus seats are important this year so that we all remain a safe distance apart at all times.
- All students are encouraged to bring water bottles to school. They can fill them in our bottle fillers located in each section of the school. We are not allowing regular water fountain use for safety reasons.
- Each grade level has designated doors to enter and exit daily. Please see BELOW map for details.

Albright Student Drop-Off and Pickup Procedures

Buses will pull up in the back of the building on Myrtle Avenue and this is our bus lane. For the safety of all, student drop off is not permitted on Myrtle Avenue. Buses will unload one at a time to stagger arrival. Students will walk off the bus and find a color visual marker by their grade level entrance.

Car riders will park in the Harrison Street or Villa Avenue lots and students will walk to their grade level door, while staying socially distant from peers. They will head to their grade level entrance and find a color visual marker prior to their temperature screening.

- 5th Grade Door #9 On the South End of the Black Top
- 6th Grade Door #4 Athletic Entrance by Soccer Fields
- 7th Grade Door #5 Back of Building by Cafeteria
- 8th Grade Door #11 On the North End of the Black Top

Dismissal

Buses will pick up in the back of the building on Myrtle Avenue and this is our bus lane. For the safety of all, student pick up is not permitted on Myrtle Avenue. Students will be dismissed by class so as to stagger exiting the building. Students can not ride a bus other than the one they are assigned and must sit in their assigned seat.

Car Riders:

If you are picking up your child from school, please park in the Harrison Street or Villa Avenue lots and your child will walk to your vehicle, while staying socially distant from peers.

MEALS ARE FREE FOR ALL STUDENTS UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2020

Every child in our school district is eligible for the **free** combo breakfast/lunch meals as long as they are 18 or under. If we have more parents picking up meals than we have meals that day, they will be asked to go over to Jackson Middle School in Villa Park, IL (DuPage District 45) since District 48 and 45 food service programs have merged.

**For students enrolled in eLearning, we will provide combo breakfast/lunch grab and go meals for the week every Tuesday in front of the District 48 Administrative Offices door between 1:00 and 1:30pm.

**Students participating in hybrid learning will be able to take a combo breakfast/lunch meal home with them each day. AM hybrid students have their lunch for that day and breakfast for the following day Monday through Friday. PM hybrid students have their breakfast and lunch for the following day Monday through Friday.
