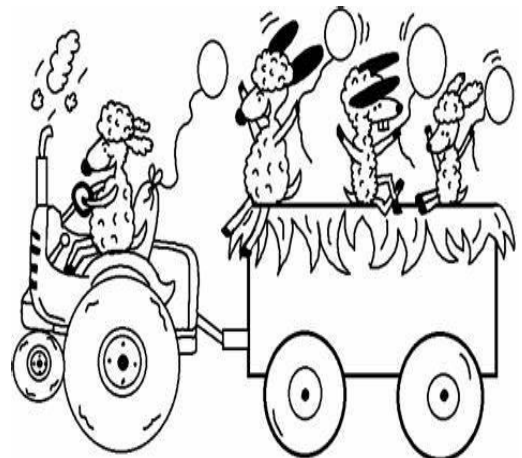

Students will practice daily and be tested weekly.

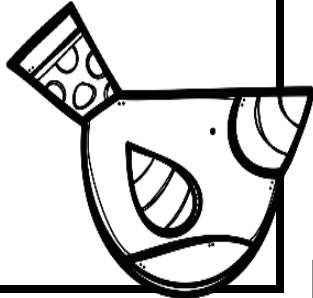
Problem Solving
