Vision screens will take place the week of October 5th. If your child has prescription glasses/contacts, please ensure they bring them to school. Parents will be notified if your child does not pass the screening.

Lost and Found-please have your child check the lost and found regularly. We will be donating items bi-weekly. Thank you.



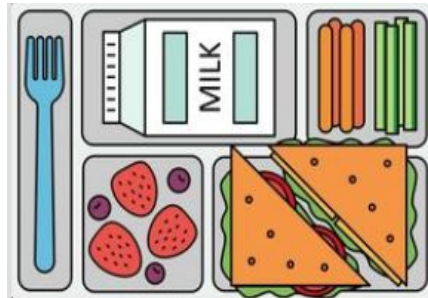

FREE MEALS TO ALL CHILDREN (18 YEARS & up; YOUNGER).

Who can get free meals? Any student, whether they are doing in-person learning at school or virtual/remote learning at home, can get free meals. Free meals are also available to children 18 years & up; younger who are not enrolled in our school/district. This includes younger children who are not in school yet, children enrolled in other districts and children who are homeschooled. This is expected to end at winter break so please do not forget to fill out a free and reduced form so you are ready to go after winter break.

When does this start?

Free meals are available now for students attending in-person school. Starting Wednesday, September 23rd meals will be available for curbside pick up once a week from 11-12 at the front entrance of Cody High School for children not attending school in person, or attending our rural schools.
