A total of 1,604 people completed the survey

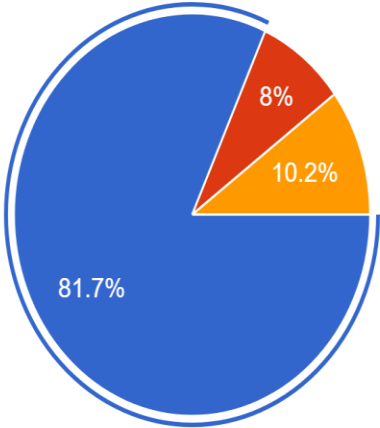

Are you a parent, staff member of FCSC or both?

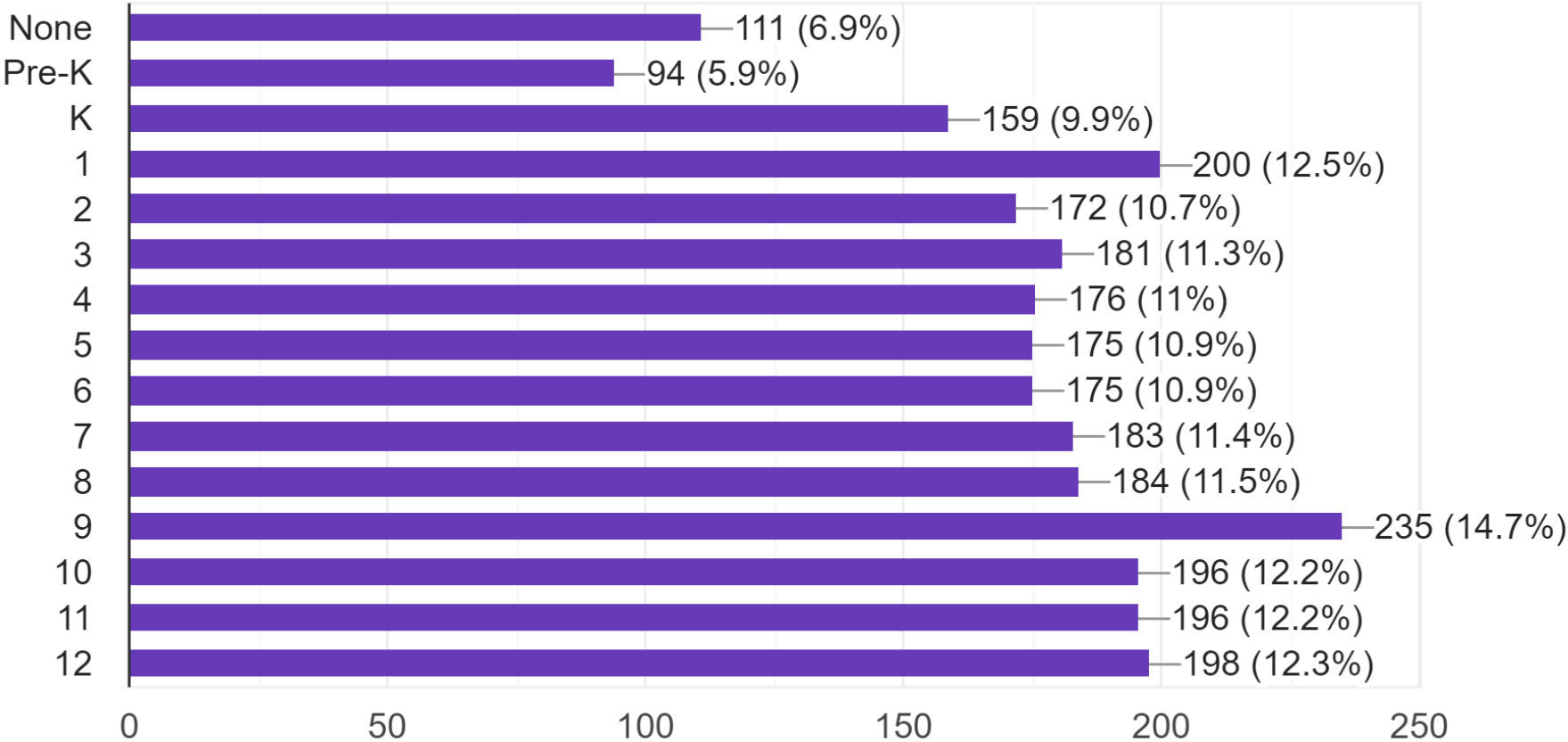

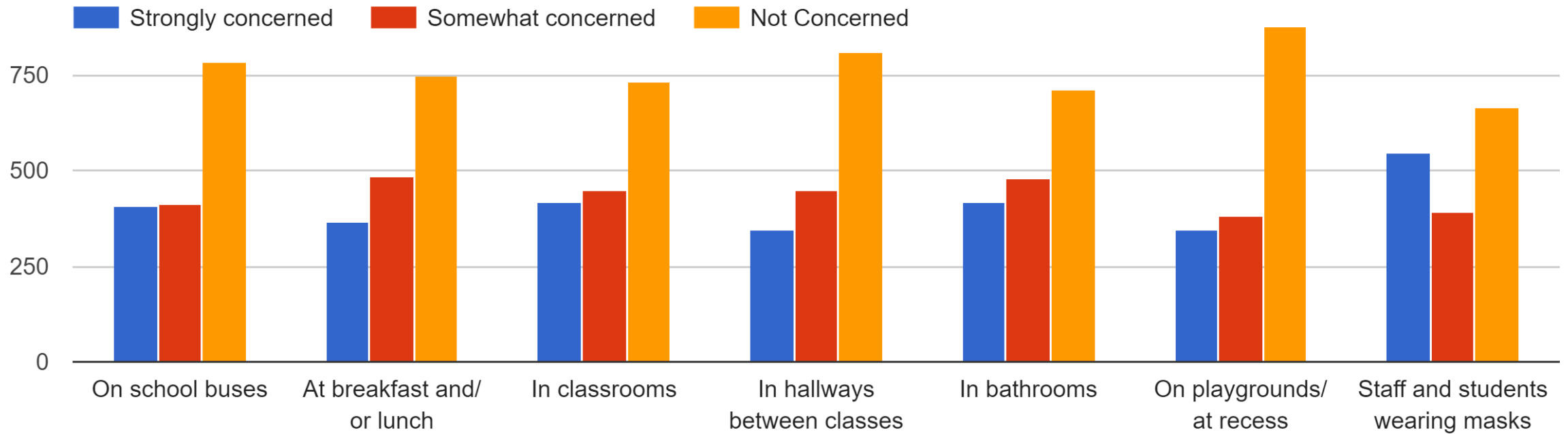

What grade will your child(ren) be in for the 2020-2021 school year? Mark all that apply.

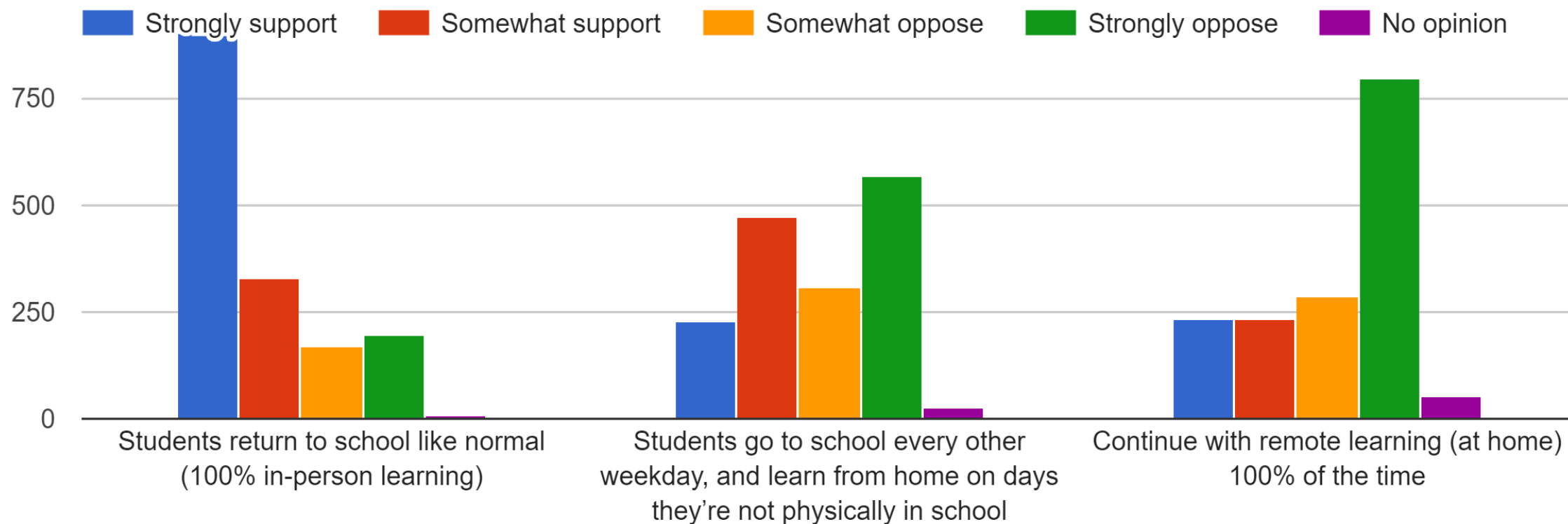

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS

We have received a lot of feedback on our survey and in conversations with parents and staff members. There are seven areas where feedback was most significant:

- Improve our eLearning/Remote Learning plan and have that option available if we need to close school again or to support children unable to attend**
- Concern about requiring face masks to be worn, primarily mandating face masks be worn**
- Social distancing - how we monitor and enforce this at school and on buses**

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS

- **Cleaning of our facilities and preventing the sharing of equipment and supplies when possible**
- **Kids at all grades need to have laptops/devices that are not shared, including elementary students**
- **Adjust attendance policies and eliminate attendance incentives**
- **Parents must check their children each day for COVID-19 symptoms and not send them to school if sick**
