Summer School Success

Due to Covid 19 restrictions, we did not have summer school on the CHS campus. We encouraged any student to sign up for online classes through the Indiana online Academy. Students were required to pay \$50 of the \$250 online fee so that they had some incentive to pass the class. That proved to be very successful, again!

Summer 2020- 174 students took 217 classes. (we had only 12 Failures)

Did You Know?

CHS allows at-risk 8th grader repeaters to attend CHS for high school credits? They are here for three periods and then return to CMS. We call these students "Bridge Students" and the program has proven very successful.

Middle School "Life-skills" students are now at CHS. It has allowed consolidation of resources and personnel.

CHS does not retain students in their current grade for failure. When entering CHS as 9th graders, they are put in a cohort to graduate in four years. In those four years, they must pass all of the classes to graduate. Some students graduate in three years! If your student fails classes, and gets behind, they should take summer school to catch up!

Things to Remember

- The new entrance to CHS is behind the school. Please enter the doors under the big Spartan Head!
- There is no entry to CHS, at the front gate, during school hours.
- You must call the school if your student is absent.
 If we have asked you to quarantine your student(s), then you do not need to call.
- Picture make-up day is scheduled for Thursday October 15. This is also a day that online students could come in for pictures.
- The window to move to online school is closed.
 Your student may move back to regular school at any time.
- Homecoming events are postponed until Covid 19 restrictions are lifted by the Governor. A replacement date will be announced at a later date.
