iPad Policy Agreement Form

By signing this form, you agree to comply with the iPad Policy of Tallassee City Schools. The policy is available in full on the iPad and at www.tcschools.com. Provided below is a summary of the agreement.

- If the iPad is physically damaged or broken, the student will pay a repair fee of \$50.
- The iPad belongs to the Tallassee City School District. Each student is required to pay the \$50 technology fee each year.
***21-22 Technology Fee has been waived by the Tallassee City School Board of Education**
- If the iPad is lost or stolen, the student will be responsible for the replacement cost of the iPad.
- If the iPad is considered defective with no physical damage, it will be replaced. Any problem with the iPad should be reported as soon as possible.
- The student must follow all technology rules which are provided in the iPad Policy and Code of Conduct.
 - This includes tampering with the device hardware or software.
 - Abusing software on the device for unintended purposes.
 - Failure to comply may result in limiting a student's technology freedoms and could result in loss of all iPad privileges.
- You must follow the reporting procedures for damage or issues to your iPad.
- You may not use any other student's device or accounts.
 - Doing so is considered hacking and is in violation of Section 13A-8-103 [Alabama Computer Crime Act] and may be dealt with accordingly.
- All devices must have the protective case that was provided by TSC and passcode on at all times.
 - Only the school provided case is allowed.
 - Safety of your device must be your highest priority concerning these devices if we are to preserve their usability over the years.
- Malicious Activity
 - All activity on iPads is tracked by the school.
 - Students will not be allowed to add or remove applications. Any attempt to alter the iPad in any way, will be considered malicious.
