Budget Information: FY16 & FY17

The under-reported truth to the latest budget is the fact this truly is a stop-gap budget. While education is tentatively scheduled to be funded through the end of the FY17 year on June 30, the reality is the revenue question has never been solved. Bi-partisan agreement will still be required and the Governor continues to be insistent on his turnaround agenda while the Speaker continues to be completely anti-reform. The veto session will begin one week after the November 8 election. Mr. Hinman also presented figures for the FY16 budget. The FY17 Budget is dialed in as tightly as possible and we're going to be relying on everyone to stay within their means. Generally, our staff does really well but we're asking for extra diligence this year.

Department of Labor New Overtime Rules

Recently, the US Department of Labor (DOL) issued a final rule regarding overtime pay requirements under the Fair Labor Standards Act. Most significantly, the final rule increases the salary threshold under which most works are entitled to receive overtime pay from \$455 per week to \$913 per week, effective December 1, 2016. This does not apply to teachers or employees in a supervisory role.
