PARCC Testing

We were receiving several inquiries in regard to opting students out of the PARCC assessments. With the exams starting at the GS Monday, it appears only 2 students have opted out. At the MS, exams are scheduled to begin on Tuesday with 9 students so far pledged to forego PARCC. We had assumed there would be a social media frenzy promoting the opt-out option, but it didn't seem to occur and we had very few issues with test administration. Districts continue getting caught in the middle of the State Board of Education and empowered parents who are standing up against the administration of these exams they see as linked to the common core. The district is taking the approach of not worrying about anything associated with PARCC; not the administration of the test, our technological preparation, the results, student opt out, etc. Mr. Hinman has voiced his concerns to the ISBE, they have made the decision to proceed, we are under their authority and submit to their decision.
