### Procedure 2404P

#### Demonstrating Competency/Proficiency in Science

The district will manage the assessment process so that students seeking competency-based credit can demonstrate competency/proficiency in science. Students may demonstrate competence in the following ways:

1. The student may recover up to 1 science credit following a failed or incomplete science course if the student meets standard on a state assessment in science;
2. The student may recover up to 1 science credit following a failed or incomplete science course if the student meets standard on another approved state alternative that meets the graduation requirement.
3. The student may obtain up to 1 science credit for passing an Odysseyware end of course assessment in a like course. Students do not need to have attempted and failed a course before being eligible for this option.

Additionally, the student may demonstrate competency/proficiency in a science subject and be awarded credit if the student achieves a C or higher grade in the next-higher level course in that science subject or closely related subject.
