ACCELERATED READING

A letter went home with students in grades 1-6 about our use of AR. For those who are unfamiliar with AR, this stands for Accelerated Reader. It is a program we use to help students work on Reading Comprehension and build excitement for reading because it gives points for tests you take on books you choose to read. Those points are then rewarded here at school.

The goals for the 2020-2021 school year are as follows:

First Grade-5 points

Second Grade-12 points

Third Grade-14 points

Fourth Grade-16 points

Fifth Grade-18 points

Sixth Grade-20 points

I also have a program called the Knights Reading Club that recognizes students based off the number of words they read. There are seven levels of the Knights Reading Club and once a student reaches all seven levels, they are considered an All-Star Reader in the school. In order to make it to the Knights Reading Club, students must meet these goals: *notice this has changed since previous years

1st Grade-50,000 words

2nd Grade-100,000 words

3rd Grade-200,000 words

4th Grade-400,000 words

5th Grade-500,000 words

6th Grade-600,000 words

Any student who reaches 1,000,000 words, will be given a spot in the Millionaire's Wall of Fame!! This is a new incentive we are implementing this year and I am very excited about it.
