Physical Form:

This is required by the State of Illinois for the above mentioned students and is acceptable if dated within the past 12 months prior to the first day of school. Exam forms may be obtained from the school office. Consult your physician regarding lead screening for children younger than 6 years old. **Please remember to fill out the health history portion, sign and date.**

Immunization Requirements:

- **DTAP (Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus):** Pre-K students should have received 4 doses of Dtap. Kindergarten through 5th grades should have received 4 or more doses of Dtap with the last dose being a booster and having been received on or after the 4th birthday. Students in 6th through 12th grades should have received one dose of Tdap.
- **Polio:** Students entering at any grade level should have received 4 or more doses of Polio, with the last dose having been received on or after the 4th birthday. Pre-K students should have 3 or more doses of Polio.
- **MMR:** Students entering at Kindergarten through 12th grades must have two MMR Vaccines, the first dose should be on or after the 1st birthday. Pre-K students should have at least one MMR Vaccine, this dose must be on or after the students 1st birthday.
- **HIB (Haemophilus Influenzae Type B):** Pre-K Students should have 1 Hib Vaccination on or after 15 months of age to be compliant. Kindergarten through 12th grade do not require this vaccine due to age.
- **Hepatitis B:** All students entering school should have 3 doses of Hepatitis B to complete the series, following the correct dosing schedule.
- **Varicella (Chicken Pox):** Pre-K students should have received one dose on or after the 1st birthday. Students entering Kindergarten through 12th grades must have a total of two doses, the first dose should be on or after the 1st birthday.
- **Pneumococcal:** Pre-K students should have received the primary series or at least one dose between 24 to 59 months of age. Kindergarten through 12th grades do not require this vaccine due to age.
- **Meningococcal: NEW FOR 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR.** Students entering 6th grade needs to show proof of having received 1 dose on or after the 11th birthday. Students entering 12th grade should have received 2 doses, the 1st dose on or after the 11th birthday and the 2nd dose on or after the 16th birthday.

Dental:

Dental exams are required for students entering into Kindergarten, 2nd Grade, and 6th Grade, homeschooled, moved into the district from out of state. This form can be obtained in the school office.

Vision:

Vision exams are required for all students entering into Kindergarten, homeschooled or those who have moved into the district from out of state. This form can be obtained in the school office.

ALL FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY A PARENT/GUARDIAN BEFORE TURNING INTO THE OFFICE.
