 - Guilderland minimum grade policy
 - Grade 9/10 45 for all four quarters
 - Grade 11/12 40 for all four quarters
 - Must have attendance rate of at least 50% to qualify; if not true grade is earned.
 - C-D policy
 - Application process
 - o can only be used once a year in each subject area
 - i.e. math & science quarter 1 can not be used again for the year.
 - Amsterdam
 - Quarter 1-3 minimum 55%, 4th quarter grade as earned
 - Catskill
 - O Quarter 1 & 2 minimum 50%
 - → Like attendance tied to minimum grade, application process
