

Prom Rules

1. The age limit for prom will be Freshman thru 20 years of age.
2. If the attendee is a student at RHHS they must attend ALL day the day before prom or they will be unable to attend, unless approved by the principal.
3. A junior and or attendee may not have any outstanding bills. All bills must be paid by April 9.
4. All students and their dates will be searched before departing for the prom destination, if found contraband will be grounds for nonparticipation.
5. If the sponsors suspect alcohol or drug usage before departure, the attendee will not be allowed to attend the prom.
6. Only prom attendees are allowed at the prom destination.
7. All attendees must ride the provided transportation to and from the prom destination.
8. All attendees will have assigned buses and seating at prom. Bus seating will be at the sponsor's discretion.
9. Only prom attendees and sponsors are allowed on the buses.
10. Any individual will be held responsible for any property damaged or destroyed during the time of prom. The junior class will not accept legal responsibility.
11. All attendees will be held responsible for their actions while under the guidance of the sponsors. The sponsors retain the right to call and use legal force if necessary.
12. All juniors are responsible to sell predetermined number of magazines or items, work the football concession stands, and bring a predetermined number of auction items before they qualify to attend prom.
13. All prom attendees may be subject to a background check for criminal records and may be eliminated from the prom list.
14. All chaperons must be an employee of the RHHS certified staff.
15. All juniors and seniors must have their date signed in and Prom Rules and signed and turned in by April 9th; the list will be reviewed by the principal.
16. At after- prom the attendees must sign in and when they sign out they may not return.
17. All participants must be approved by the principal. (Handbook Guidelines)
18. Seniors graduating at semester will not be allowed to attend prom except as an invited guest.
19. If the invited guest is not a RHHS junior or senior the date is responsible to pay a designated fee.
20. The principal has the discretion to cancel any students or prom guest's attendance at any time.
21. Any senior who did not pay their junior debt will be eliminated from prom until the debt is paid.
22. The prom attendee must be a student in good standing at RHHS, which includes but in not limited to attendance, discipline, tardies, or questionable behavior.
