## COVID-19 Symptoms Screening Tool for Families

Use this questionnaire each day. Follow the instructions for when to keep your child home from school and how to report the symptoms to the Warroad Public Schools' Health Office.

### Does your child have ONE or MORE of these symptoms?

- Fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Difficulty or trouble breathing
- New cough or a cough that gets worse
- New loss of taste or smell

If a child has one or more of these symptoms, they must stay home and should stay away from others as much as possible, including family members. Notify the school health office at (218)386-6044 or (218)242-2583.

If there are no symptoms, go to the next question.

### Does your child have AT LEAST TWO of these symptoms?

- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Chills
- Muscle Pain
- Excessive Fatigue (extreme tiredness)
- New or severe headache
- New nasal congestion or runny nose

If a child has one or more of these symptoms, they must stay home and should stay away from others as much as possible, including family members. Notify the school health office at (218)386-6044 or (218)242-2583.

If there are no symptoms, go to the next question.

### Has your child been diagnosed with COVID-19 since they last went to school?

- No. Your child may come to school.
- Yes. Your child must stay at home in isolation and away from others as much as possible. Notify the school nurse for instructions at (218)242-2583.

### Has your child had close contact in the last 14 days with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 or has someone from the health department contacted you and said your child should stay home in quarantine?

- No. Your child may come to school.
- Yes. Your child must stay at home in isolation and away from others as much as possible. Notify the school nurse for instructions at (218)242-2583.

### Is your child or someone else in your household who has symptoms of COVID-19 waiting for COVID-19 test results?

- No. Your child may come to school.
- Yes. Your child must stay at home in isolation and away from others as much as possible. Notify the school nurse for instructions at (218)242-2583.

**Note:** Your child may still need to stay home for other illnesses that have symptoms that are similar to COVID-19, such as strep throat or stomach illness. Notify the school health office at (218)386-6044 or (218)242-2583.
