Notice: Suspension of Remote Learning Option

Date: September 30, 2020

Remote learning has been a suggested response to those concerned about returning to school due to COVID-19. After reviewing the data from the first six-weeks, it is apparent this approach has not been successful for most students. Therefore, Snook ISD is suspending remote learning across all campuses effective October 9, 2020. The only exceptions will be for those students who are told to quarantine by the school district or the public health department due to close contact exposures or a positive test result for COVID-19; or for students with documented medical concerns. If we begin to see health concerns develop, we will revisit this option.

Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup> is an in-service day for our teachers and staff and a holiday for our students. **All students enrolled in Snook ISD must begin attending on-campus instruction on or before Tuesday, October 13<sup>th</sup>.** Please prepare to make a decision that best suits your family.

While we strongly believe on-campus instruction at Snook ISD is the best option for all children, there are some other options you could consider if you do not believe it is in your child's best interest to return to our campus by October 13<sup>th</sup>.

Campus administrators will be contacting a parent/guardian of each remote learner over the next week to discuss steps needed to return your child back to Snook ISD campuses by Tuesday, October 13. If you have concerns related to COVID and your child's safety, we will be happy to discuss those with you at that time.

Thank you for working with our district through this very difficult time. We look forward to a closer return to normalcy and want to reiterate that we strongly hope to have your child back in our Snook ISD classrooms!
