## **Fall 2020 Spectator Policy- Updated for 10/2**

### **Expectations of Home Team**

- a. Coaches will provide a list of parent/guardians to AD
- b. Max 2 tickets per rostered player & coaches

### **Expectations of Visiting Team Athletic Directors**

- a. Send a list of parent/guardian names no later than morning of a game
- b. Max 2 tickets per rostered player & coaches for visiting teams

### **Expectations of PLAYERS & COACHES**

- a. Screening must happen before entering a game site, either before you get on the bus or upon arrival
- b. Wear a properly fitting face covering at all times, preferably 2-ply and cloth
- c. Cannot enter the facility without a face covering properly covering your mouth and nose. Must wear the face covering (properly) until you leave the facility
- d. Remain a minimum of 6' away from everyone else unless actively participating in a competition or drill. This includes walking in and out of practice and games
- e. Establish a new way to celebrate with your teammates when they / you do something worth celebrating, no high fives, no fist bumps, no chest bumps, no pig piles
- f. Leave immediately after your competition ends
- g. Wash hands (Sanitize) as soon as you arrive at the facility, throughout your competition, before you leave the facility

### **Expectations of GUESTS**

- a. Wear a properly fitting face covering at all times, preferably 2-ply and cloth
- b. All Spectators will be screened at the MAIN GATE before entering the event.
- c. Guests are limited to those who are on the list from visiting team
- d. Outside guests, other than those related to the athlete and on the list, will not be allowed on campus
- e. All other athletic department expectations remain in effect (sportsmanship, staying behind the ropes/fence, etc.)

### **Expectations of GAME STAFF**

- a. Wear a properly fitting face covering at all times, preferably 2-ply and cloth
- b. Games will be staffed by 1 ticket taker, security, and 1 police officer
- c. Spectators will be checked in through 1 point of entry at the MAIN GATE. Booths will contain lists of reserved tickets as shared by MAU Athletic Department and visiting team's AD. Guests check in at the table, their names get crossed off, and they enter the

venue. Gate personnel will remain at the gate for the duration of the event to make sure no additional spectators gain access to the venue.

**Notes**

- a. Portable toilets will be available at game fields
- b. No building access
- c. No Booster Club Concession
- d. No artificial noise makers
- e. No admission
