Attendance Policy

PLEASE REMEMBER: A parent or guardian must call the school at 269-484-2148 by 7:30 AM the morning following the absence and must call in each day a student is absent. In the event of an absence, an automated phone call will take place. The phone call will indicate any portion of the day that has been missed. It is not specific to the class period. The student and parent/guardian shall be notified when a student acquires a total of six (6) excused and/or unexcused absences during a semester and again when a student acquires a total of ten (10) excused and/or unexcused absences. Students who meet the ten-absence rule may be reported to the Truancy Officer for investigation.
