NOTICE OF BOARD WORKSHOP MEETING OF THE TYLER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, October 8, 2020, the Board of Trustees of the Tyler Independent School District will hold a Board Workshop meeting at 11:00 AM at the Jim Plyler Instructional Complex, Dr. Jack L. Davidson Conference Center, 807 W. Glenwood, Tyler, TX. The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda which is attached to and made a part of this Notice.

Texas Government Code Section:

551.071	Private consultation with the board's attorney.
551.072	Discussing purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
551.073	Discussing negotiated contracts for prospective gifts or donations.
551.074	Discussing personnel or to hear complaints against personnel.
551.076	Considering the deployment, specific occasions for, or implementation of, security personnel or devices.
551.082	Considering discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel.
551.083	Considering the standards, guidelines, terms, or conditions the board will follow, or will instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups.
551.084	Excluding witnesses from a hearing.

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof; as the School Board shall determine.

Subject: Bilingual / English as a Second Language Annual Program Effectiveness Report

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

According to Chapter 89 of the Texas Education Code, all school districts are required to annually present a bilingual education and/or English as a second language (ESL) program effectiveness report to ensure students are academically successful.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

Chapter 89 requires the annual Bilingual/ESL report to include:

Academic progress of English learners:

- Progress of English learners in their language of instruction
- The extent to which English learners are becoming proficient in English.
- The number of students who have been exited from the Bilingual/ESL Program
- Professional Development for teachers of bilingual students or English learners.

For Districts who have filed ESL waivers or Bilingual exceptions:

- The number of teachers for whom an exception or waiver was filed.
- The number of teachers for whom exceptions or waivers were filed who obtained their certification.
- The frequency and scope of the professional development to assist teachers for whom waivers and exceptions were filed.

Subject: Class Size Update

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) required each school district in Texas to conduct a class size enrollment survey for grades K-4. If the survey indicated classes for grades K-4 exceeded the allowable class size limit of 22:1, the districts were required to submit a request and a copy of theBoard approved compliance plan to the State Wavier Unit. At the June 19, 2017 meeting the board approved the District of Innovation (DOI) Plan; therefore, this wavier exemption is no longer required. The administration makes all attempts to maintain the class size limit of 22:1 ratio; however, a qualified teacher aide will be provided when ratios are exceeded if all students are in person.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

As of September 30, 2020, this list reflects classes that exceed the 22:1 class size limit.

- 12 classes may require teacher aide support if all students return per Tyler ISD Return to Learn protocols.
- The 12 classes are over by a total of 19 students.
