Dear Parents/Guardians:

Granby Public Schools have been approved to serve breakfast and lunch to all children under the age of 18, at no cost to children and families, regardless of income. This program has been made possible through funding provided by the USDA in response to the exceptional circumstances of this public health emergency.

Meals provided through this program are available to the Granby community beginning on Monday, October 5, until December 31, 2020 on those days that schools are in session. There is no paperwork required to receive these meals.

Breakfast and lunch will be available in our school cafeterias for students attending schools at this time. **Please note that breakfast is currently not available at the high school.** Items such as bottled beverages and other “a la carte items” are available as well; however, these items are not included in the USDA program.

Children who are 18 years or younger that are distance learning or who are not enrolled in Granby Public Schools, may pre-order and pick up meals at a specified time through the process outlined below:

- **For this week only, please email your choices no later than 3:00pm Sunday October 4. We will communicate further details for pre-ordering the following weeks by October 7.**
- Please include the name(s) of the child(ren) who are benefiting from the program.
- Food may be picked up between 9:30am and 10:00am in front of the Granby Memorial Middle School located at 321 Salmon Brook Street in Granby.
- **For the week of October 5 only:**
 - Monday meals may be picked up on Monday.
 - Tuesday meals may be picked up on Tuesday.
 - Meals for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday may be picked up on Wednesday.
- We will communicate further details for pick-up time for the following weeks by October 7.
