Dear Patron of USD 410:

We need your help to establish priorities for repairs and improvements concerning our school facilities. This survey is the first step to involve our community in this decision process. Enclosed you will find a short survey which each person ages 18 and above should complete before May 19.

The board of education is considering needed facility improvements in the district and a “no tax increase” bond election to finance those improvements. A “no tax increase” bond would be possible by paying off the current school bond and financing a new school bond. The district believes approximately \$14 million could be raised for needed projects in the district with no tax increase to patrons. The district’s intent is to only consider those projects which could be financed without a tax increase. The survey, therefore, will be extremely valuable as the district establishes priorities for maintenance and other facility improvements that would benefit students. Survey results will be made available to the public at the June 12 meeting of the board of education.
