Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

October 5th is finally upon us. On Monday, we will have our first day of in school instruction for all our students. We are looking forward to seeing more students coming to school on the same day.

Please be aware that if cases of COVID-19 continue to rise in Lebanon and in surrounding towns, we might have to make very quick changes back to hybrid or to distance learning. You will be informed as soon as possible.

In school Instruction

Starting Monday, Oct. 5th, all students will report to school except for those who have selected distance learning. In school instruction will be 5 days/week. Wednesdays will be Early Release schedule. We will use Wednesday afternoons to provide needed support for our distance learning students and for parent and staff meetings. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday will be full days.

Schedule and instructional strategy changes may become necessary as we settle in to educating students who attend school 5 days/week and our students who are in distance learning 5 days/week. If we find we need to make changes, we will communicate them to you.

Distance Learning

Parents/guardians continue to have the option to choose all distance learning for their children. Please complete the Distance Learning option form and return it to your child's school. Parents can also switch from distance learning back to in school instruction. This can be communicated directly with your child's school.

Classroom Concerns

Just as before COVID-19, parents who have questions about instruction, grading, assignments, behaviors, and other classroom concerns may contact their children's teachers directly.
