

Please take a minute to setup your child's iPad if you haven't done so yet.


- 1. Login with the school given appleID

Friendship Group

Dear Families,

As the School Mental Health Professionals at Kelly Lane Primary School, we will be working closely with students, families, and teachers. Your children know us as "The Helping Teachers" at school.



Throughout this school year, we will be conducting various Friendship Groups, where students will learn how to interact positively with their peers, resolve conflicts, participate effectively in group situations, and respect themselves and those around them. On occasion, students may be chosen by their teacher or a peer to attend a Friendship Group. Often, students who attend on a one-time basis serve the role as a peer model. Sessions will be held outside the classroom for approximately 30 minutes. If your child is chosen to participate in a group in this way, we will send you a notice in their take home folder that afternoon letting you know that your child participated in a Friendship Group. To ensure the health and safety of our students who participate in Friendship Group we will be taking the following precautions; increased cleaning before and after we see students, using hand sanitizer, wearing face masks/face shields and the use of a plexiglass shield that allows the students to see the activity and each other but helps to maintain the proper distance and provides protection.

If you do not want your child to participate in a Friendship Group, please notify us via email at pomeroyl@granbyschools.org or pagec@granbyschools.org, so we make sure not to take them from class. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or concerns. Thanks so much and welcome back to school!

MESSAGE FROM THE CLINIC

October is the month to set up an appointment with your child's pediatrician for a flu shot.

Flu season is coming! The flu is a serious contagious disease and the flu vaccine is the most important step you can take in protecting against the flu.

<u>Attention Parents of Preschoolers:</u> All preschoolers in the state of CT are required to have the flu vaccine: 1 dose administered each year of preschool between August 1st-December 31st. Please provide proof of the flu vaccine after your child receives it.

Clothing Items

The clinic has a small supply of clothes, but may not always have the size your child may need. If you would like to donate any clothes, we would greatly appreciate it! NATIONAL BUS SAFETY AWARENESS

In the month of October, we celebrate National Bus Safety Awareness Week (Oct. 19-23). We will reviewing bus safety in our classrooms during that week and a special thank you to all of our Granby bus drivers that transport us to and from school every day.

Please take a moment to talk to your child about bus safety and following the bus rules such as staying in your seat quietly, keeping hands and feet to yourself and remembering to wear your mask.





Please do not drop your children off before 8:15am. There is no supervision before that time. Please use both semi-circle in front of the school and the parking lot entrance to drop off your student. During drop off in the morning, please have your child exit from the right side of the car, on the sidewalk. We can

not double up the cars for drop off. Students should not be crossing the drop off lanes. **If you are dropping off after 8:30, please utilize the second driveway, as the front, half circle is used for bus drop off.** If your child is in a car seat or needs assistance, you can use the second entrance for a little more space and time. <u>If you are dropping off after 8:45 you will need to bring them to the school entrance and buzz the office and we will come and your child.</u>

End of Day Pick-Up Procedure

If your child is not on the "permanent pick up list" and you need to pick them up early or at the end of the day you must write a *dated note to the teacher with the first and last name, printed, of your child and their teacher, on the day of the pick up* (if you were unable to write a note please call or email the office as soon as possible).

PICK UP PROCEDURE (Please read carefully):

During pick up, we will be utilizing both entrance ways, please pull up to a numbered cone, have your family sign in the window and we will call for your child. Please be patient during this time. When you pull up to a cone, a staff member will call for your child and then we will bring your child to your car. **Parents can not come into the building to pick up their child during this time.** If a staff member does not know you, you may be asked for an ID. Thank you for your understanding.

If you have a <u>GOLD</u> student, you will use the front, semi circle bus lane, to <u>pick up</u> (between 2:50-3:15 only) your child. If you have a <u>MAROON</u> student you will use the parking lot entrance and drive to the back towards the playground to <u>pick up</u> (between 2:50-3:30 only) your student at the side of building. Please pull up to a numbered cone and a staff member will call for your child. *It is helpful if you have the door open and help your child into their car seat.*

If you are picking up after 3:15, <u>you must use the parking lot</u> <u>entrance</u> (the semi-cirle area is used for the buses starting at 3:15).
