Annually, all students at G-AMS take part in the math and reading NWEA MAP Growth Assessment. Students complete this assessment in the fall, winter, and spring. It is an effective tool in measuring academic achievement and growth. Teachers then utilize the assessment results in planning their lessons and targeting their instruction. Working within the Hybrid Learning Model, we have had to creatively schedule our testing times and still remain within the testing window. Students will wrap up testing by the end of October.
