Dear Parents & Guardians,

Under state law, all schools in Illinois must conduct an active shooter drill with students present. The Dwight Police Department's ALICE instructors, in conjunction with several ALICE certified instructors from our district will be facilitating the drill for Dwight Township High School. The drill will be on Monday, October 26th.

All students will have reviewed the ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) concepts prior to the drill. All students will participate in a more active/spontaneous drill. The safety of the students and staff is the number one objective for these drills.

Our goal is not to scare students, but to prepare them. Air horns may be used to simulate gunfire, but blanks or simulation rounds (airsoft, Nerf, etc.) or any other types of firearm projectiles will not be used at any time during the drills. These types of drills are a valuable way for students and staff to practice making good decisions related to our ALICE concepts.
