We are proud to let you know that this year all of our teachers are fully certified in the field that they are teaching.

An evaluation on Title I was conducted during a meeting on September 18, 2019 on 2018-2019 school year using teacher surveys, Title I Schoolwide Rubric and assessment data. A comprehensive needs assessment was also completed by our District Leadership team. Both were used to plan for the coming year. Both of these documents were included in our Parent Packets at Open House and are posted on our school website.

The conclusion of this evaluation was that we would continue the interventions and programs that are in our plan from the previous year. Using ACT Aspire Interims has had positive results for our students. These interims are used to track the progress of students and adjust as needed their individual plans for reaching achievement. We will continue to use Moby Max for tracking student progress and intervention. Leadership teams will work closely with teachers on ensuring that the Title I activities are being implemented effectively.

Parent and Family Engagement Plan was included in our Parent Packets at Open House and posted on our website. Our Parent Facilitators at each campus plan activities for the school year.

All parent activities that are conducted during the year are also advertised on our teleparent system, website posting, and social media. Our Technology Coordinator adds information to our website and
