

MMS Remote Learning Day

- **Student Responsibility**
 - Teachers will need to prepare an assignment for students to complete on Friday.
 - This should be a review or recap of the week OR an independent assignment. **It should not be new instruction.**
 - Students will download the assignment for Friday before they leave class on Thursday.
 - Please remember, students have 7 classes and we are not trying to overload them with work. We do not expect them to work the equivalent of a whole school day.

- **Teacher Responsibility**
 - Friday will be an opportunity to focus on virtual instruction.
 - Teachers should:
 - Contact virtual students and/or parents of virtual students
 - Prepare and monitor virtual instruction
 - Plan and collaborate with their partner teacher or PLC
 - Get additional support and training for Teams, Screen-cast-o-matic, and any other resources.
 - Reminder: This is a work day, so make sure we use it wisely!

- **On-Campus Option**
 - There may be some students who choose to come to school on the Remote Learning Day.
 - Those students will work on their assignments under the supervision of the floating subs and campus aides.
 - Each teacher will need to take their regularly scheduled planning period to provide support for these students.

- Busses will not run.

- Breakfast and lunch will be served, and all students will continue to have access to free breakfast and lunch.
