Dear Parents and Guardians,

It has been a whirlwind of events and emotions for many of us in the last 72 hours. We have learned more about the process of contact tracing and quarantine as it has become a reality for several of our students. I wanted to take this opportunity to try and crystallize the school's position and plan as we continue to move forward in this uncharted, unprecedented time.

At this point, the school aims to continue to provide an option that allows for parent choice as it relates to the education of their child. We would like to re-communicate and update information pertaining to the live remote option (LRO). We respect the decisions of each individual parent as to what the best educational option is for their child. We know that there are different perspectives, priorities, opinions, circumstances, and academic and social needs that all weigh into making the best decision for your student.

If you are wishing your son or daughter to access the LRO, you must complete the following steps before your student can pursue this option:

1. Complete the Change of Learning Intention Form [HERE](#).
2. Upon receiving the request, Mrs. Harruff or I will communicate the process to your student about how to access the LRO. Students should check their school email.
3. Complete the LRO acknowledgment agreement [HERE](#). (This form must be signed and returned to me via email after completing step 1).

Additionally, we are required to update our school community with data as it relates to COVID. Please visit our [COVID 19 Resources Page](#) on the website to receive the most-up-to-date information, which will be updated weekly.

We will continue to monitor data, consider best practices and make adjustments as needed. Continued prayers to all members of our school community. As always, please email me with any questions.

9/14 - SOS members greet students in the morning in the main hallway with a pre-packaged breakfast items. During the day, SOS students will have 5 clothespins with positive messages that they will "TAG" or clip to random students' backpacks. The idea is that if you're tagged, then you pass it on to someone else. This activity will occur all week.
