Develop and distribute a school-parent compact. Example(s): The compact is sent home once a year for parents/guardians to read and make suggestions or comments.

Make sure that information related to school and parent and family programs are sent to parents/guardians in a format and language that parents/guardians can understand. Example(s): Parent Newsletters, School Calendar, Report Cards, Progress Reports,

Coordinate and integrate family engagement opportunities in order to help parents and families work in partnership with educators. Example(s): Open House/PAC Meeting, Literacy Morning \& Evening Events
