Home Maximum Capacity (West) – Currently 250 people

Visitor Maximum Capacity (East) - Currently 250 people

Home and Visiting fans are not to intermix

#### **Home Side Protocols**

Parking - North side of parking lot, entrance 1

Entrance – Main gate by the ticket booth

Tickets – Wrist band sent with player the week of the contest must be presented to gate worker

Concessions - Main concession stand on west side of stadium - North window

Seating - Main stands and standing along fence on west side of track

Spectators may not stand on track

Restrooms – Main restroom facilities on west side of stadium

Handicap Parking – Limited field side parking for handicap viewers to remain in vehicle. Must present handicap parking pass to be granted access to minimal spaces

#### **Visiting Side Protocols**

Parking - South side of parking lot, entrance 2

Entrance – Gate worker will be present by baseball dugout for fans to walk along south side of track to the east bleachers

Tickets – Wrist bands sent to opposing school must be presented to gate worker along with payment for game

Concessions - Main concession stand on west side of stadium - South window

Seating – East side of track – Minimal bleacher seating, standing on east side of track behind the barrier is okay as well as bringing own chairs to spread out the length of the field of play

Restrooms - Porta potties will be available near the visiting seating

Cheerleaders - Behind the South end zone

Handicap Parking – Limited field side parking for handicap viewers to remain in vehicle. Must present handicap parking pass to be granted access to minimal spaces on home side of venue.

#### **CHSAA Mask Requirement**

Masks are required for the duration of the event. Please don't make this an issue, it is a CHSAA requirement and is an expectation. Failure to do so may result in a request for you to leave the premises. Everyone is here for the kids and to cheer on their team please be respectful of the rules, social distance requirements and general sportsmanship amongst the two teams.

#### Media

Home – All members of the home media must remain in the North endzone of the facility

CHSAA media pass holders, yearbook staffs, and local news coverage members, etc.

Visitor – All members of the visitor media must remain in the South endzone of the facility CHSAA media pass holders, yearbook staffs, and local news coverage members, etc.

#### **Streaming**

Games will be streamed on the NFHS network produced by Yuma High School. Subscribe to Yuma High School as your home school to see all aired events!

#### **Ticket Distribution**

Each YHS football player, coach, cheerleader, and cheerleading coach, will be responsible for reserving their limited number of tickets weekly. Students and coaches will reserve tickets through a google form. Players will be asked to use their tickets on their immediate household members. If families choose to not use them on their immediate family members, players and coaches may designate them to people they feel will fill the limited seats.

YHS football players, coaches, cheerleaders, and cheer coaches will be presented with wrist bands from the YHS office after the google form has been completed. Wrist bands and facial coverings must be presented to the gate worker along with payment at the gate for entry into the event. Ticket cost are \$4 for students/senior citizen and \$6 for adults.

#### **Road Game Tickets**

Schools have the discretion to limit tickets how they feel appropriate. Less tickets may be available/player depending on what school we are playing at.

#### Visiting Team Information:

- Teams will arrive at our Ag shop located on south Ash Street. Only participants who
  have successfully passed the symptom screening process will be allowed to travel to
  contest. Game manager will greet bus and team to provide bus parking location and
  grant access to facilities.
  - a. Ag shop has a large area for game participants to spread out as well as restroom facilities
    - i. As per CHSAA requirements, teams may enter 25 at a time to change and use the restrooms. After the first group has changed, the second group of 25 may follow the same procedures
    - ii. 50 participant max allowed on roster for game

and team equipment to the east sideline of the YHS football field

- b. Ag shop DOES NOT have showers for post-game use
- 2. Water will not be provided for visiting teams
  - a. If teams are utilizing a bottle per individual, there is a hydrant located at the south end of our field across the track and near the softball field dugout closest to the field that can be used to refill water bottles.
- 3. Pre-Game, Halftime
  - a. The south endzone will be used by the visiting team for halftime talks
    - i. Participants should continue to exercise the 3'-6' foot distancing requirements as well as be masked for halftime meetings
    - ii. Restrooms in the Ag shop are available for use or a porta-potty may be positioned for player use during halftime near the endzone
- 4. Lightning
  - a. If lightning is to delay the contest, teams will return to the Ag shop and utilize more of the space to increase social distancing until lightning has ceased
- 5. Team Box
  - a. Will be extended on both sidelines to 10 yard lines. Teams must stay at least 6' back from the sideline
- 6. Student Assistants
  - a. Maximum of four Student Assistants on the sideline (student trainer, managers, etc.)

- 7. Bail Boys
  - a. Maximum of two ball boys per sideline
- 8. Pre-game Coin-toss
  - a. The coin-toss will be conducted at the CHSAA office on Thursday for all games that competitive week at all levels
- 9. Media
  - a. All media on the field must remain in the endzones up to the 5-yard line
- 10. Timeouts and between quarters
  - a. Officials may extend these times to allow sufficient time for water
- 11. Student-athlete participants and coaches
  - a. Must remain separated from spectators and sideline cheer teams at all times
- 12. Hand sanitizing stations
  - a. Will be available on both sidelines
- 13. Clock operator
  - a. Will meet the backjudge on the field pre-game rather than in the pressbox
