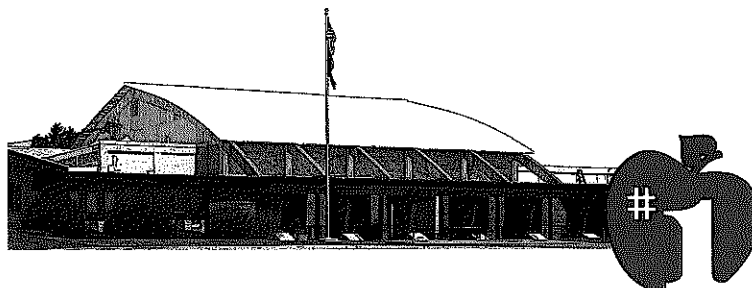

Dear Parents,

Dufur School will welcome back mid-level students to hybrid on-site learning beginning on Monday, October 12th. Each class has been split in to an A and a B pod. The A pod will be on campus on Mondays and Tuesdays; the B pod will attend on Thursdays, and Fridays. The A and B pods will alternate attending on every other Wednesday.

We anticipate that High School students will return to campus in a hybrid learning format beginning on Tuesday, October 27th.

The Dufur School staff has been working diligently on developing an educational program that will be engaging, enriching and fun. Some worry that students will be stuck in a room all day long doing on-line learning. Although on-line learning will be part of the program, it will not be the entire program. Students will have the opportunity to participate in enriching activities outside the traditional school setting. Our goal is to provide a quality education in addition to positive social experiences while in attendance in the Dufur School hybrid on-site learning program.

As students have returned to on-site learning, it has limited our ability to complete all of the food deliveries that have been possible since late August. Effective Monday, October 12th , high school students and distance-only learners need to call the school as soon as possible for weekly food boxes, which will be picked up at the school on Mondays from noon until 7:00 pm.

Kindergarten through 8th grade students on A days will have lunches provided for them to take home on their last day of school each week. Students on B days will have lunches provided for them to take home on their last day of school each week. Daily meals will still be provided at the Dufur Christian Church. We appreciate your support in this needed adjustment.
