

Dear Jackson School Parent/Guardian:

In an attempt to lessen the confusion and to also minimize our beginning of the school year transportation problems, we are requesting your cooperation in the following areas:

- Parents or another adult, please go directly to bus for student drop off and pick up for Preschool (Pre-K) students. For Kindergarten and First Grade students, parent or another adult must be visible to the bus driver at their designated bus stop.
- At Jackson School, we will be distributing bus tags to all our students that ride the bus. We would appreciate it if you would make sure that your child wears this tag for at least the first three weeks of school. The tags will be color coded to correspond with the bus that they are riding.
- Buses will be leaving Jackson school between 2:45 PM and 3:00 PM which is unfortunately a little later than initially advertised due to challenges with availability in the number of buses and drivers, seating capacity and routing.

Please note that the bus routes are always slower the first few days of school. Bus drivers use extra care to be sure all students are picked up and to reassure students their first days on the bus. Please be patient, as your child may be picked up or arrive later than originally scheduled. Regular times will quickly become established as both the drivers and students become familiar with the route, bus, and procedures.

Only Jackson students will be riding the buses that go to and from Jackson.

If you have any questions or concerns pertaining to your child's busing, do not hesitate to call.
