Please read for updates related to Northern Cass:

- 1. **Back to School Night**: Northern Cass will hold its Back to School Night on Monday, August 22nd from 5:00-7:00. Families can visit their educator's learning centers as well as pay fees for the upcoming school year. Supper will be provided and served by the Northern Cass Board of Education from 4:45-6:30. There will also be a 'photo booth' for you to take pictures.
- 2. A Few Changes for the Upcoming Year:
 - Northern Cass Learners who enroll in a VCSU dual credit course will now be required to pay \$50 for the course. Northern Cass will cover the remaining amount through federal funds.
 - Activity Passes: For the upcoming year, individuals may purchase an activity pass for \$150. If a family wants to purchase an additional pass, the cost is \$75.

- 4. Pick Up/Drop Off: There will be a change in location for our pick-up and drop-off during the 2022-23 school year due to the wear and tear on our parking lot. **Families who are dropping off their learners before school or picking them up after school will do so in the east parking lot by the east gymnasium. Learners will enter/exit the doors directly outside of the gym.
- 5. **PowerSchool v. Empower--The Difference:** PowerSchool is our school information system (SIS) which is required by the state of North Dakota. It houses your learner's cumulative information such as attendance, communications, and transcripts. Empower is our learning management system which houses our evidence, playlists, and grades. Empower is where you can check on your learner's progress (grades) towards proficiency.

- 9. Procedures for Excusing Absences--IMPORTANT
 - O Any day that a learner is absent, the parent/guardian must call the school to report the learner's absence, giving the name of the learner and the reason for the absence. Calls can be made between 7:00-9:00 a.m. at 874-2322. If the parent does not call the school, a representative of the school may call home to verify the absence. Parents/guardians e-mail attendance@northerncassschool.com prior to 9:00 a.m.

- A note from the provider who is seeing your learner must be provided to the office upon the learner's return for it to be a medically excused absence. This will not count towards a learner's overall attendance.
- If the school office does not receive either a phone call or email from the parent within 48 hours of the absence, the absence will be considered unexcused, unless deemed otherwise by administration.
- 10. **Final Forms** need to be completed for each learner prior to the beginning of the school year. Check your email for the link. You can also complete these forms with the app on your phone.
- 11. **Fees for the Upcoming Year:** Please review the <u>fee schedule</u> for lunch prices, student/class fees, and our technology fee.
