 - *Most insurances accepted, if you have Cigna insurance, please call your insurance company first to be sure you're covered.
 - *Medicaid ONLY accepted for those 18 and over.

- **10. Board of Education:** Does the Northern Cass School District have a reserve fund or carryover dollars?

- **a.** A few years back the Northern Cass School Board set a goal to carry over 12%-15% of its expenditure budget each year. On June 30, 2022, the end of the fiscal year Northern Cass Public School had a balance of \$2,010,894.91. This is 21.4% of the projected expenditure budget for the 2022-23 school year.
