 - *Medicaid ONLY accepted for those 18 and over.

- 10. **Board of Education:** What do I need to know about open meeting laws?
 - **a.** All school board meetings and all committee meetings of the school board are open to the public. All meetings must be open (NDCC 15.1-07-21); however,

portions of open meetings may be closed to address certain matters. Executive (or closed) sessions are only permitted for the following reasons:

- i. Nonrenewal and discharge procedures as covered in NDCC 15.1-15-06, 15.1-15-08, 15.1-14-06, and 15.1-14-10
- ii. To instruct negotiators or meet with an attorney when the board may reasonably predict that it may be involved in litigation as permitted in NDCC 44-04-19.1.
- iii. To discuss student educational records, including health and medical information contained therein in accordance with the Family Educational Records Privacy Act (FERPA)
- iv. To consider suspension or expulsion of a student as permitted by FERPA and ND Attorney General's Opinion No. 94-28
- v. To discuss employee medical records as outlined in NDCC 44-04-18.1
- vi. When hiring to determine three or more finalist for a position as outlined in NDCC 44-04-18.27
- **b.** Any time a school board is in executive session, a recording of the session is made and kept for possible review by the ND Attorney General.
- **c.** All handouts and materials used by the Board in an open meeting are public documents.
- **d.** All emails sent and received by school board members that deal with school business are a public record. This is the case even if you are using a private email account. It is advised not to have discussions about school business via email, text, phone, or in person with other board members outside of an open meeting.
- 11. **Compassion Fatigue:** We know your child's mental health can affect more than just your child. Are you emotionally and physically exhausted? When a parent or caregiver naturally supports someone going through a significant traumatic event, they can experience Compassion Fatigue. It is often referred to as "the cost of caring". The October Mental Health Newsletter focuses on Compassion Fatigue which outlines nine signs of compassion fatigue and provides suggested actions you can take to protect your own mind, body, and spirit. Your child's mental health is important and to continue to help your child, it is important that you are first taking time for your OWN mental health needs so you can be there for your child!
