CHAPTER 7. SCHOOL INSTRUCTION AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS

Part 1. Accreditation and Curriculum

“Transparency And Public Availability Of Public School Performance Data -- Reporting -- Availability For Timely Use To Improve Instruction “

Section 20-7-104, MCA, requires schools to report to the Montana OPI and, subsequently, publish on the Frenchtown School District website certain information that the school district is required to collect and publish. In compliance with 20-7-104, Frenchtown School District provides the following information and the links (where applicable) to access that information:

1. The total compensation for the employee, including stipends.
