Dear High School parents/guardians:

It has come to the attention of the Newell School District that a high school student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student tested positive on Thursday October 8<sup>th</sup>. The student along with his/her close contacts will be quarantined from school in accordance with the Newell Back to School Plan approved by the Newell Board of Education. Classrooms that were occupied by the student on the 8<sup>th</sup> of October are being deep cleaned and blocked off until Monday October 12<sup>th</sup>.

The COVID-19 virus is spread from person-to-person, mainly through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. Spread is more likely to occur when people are near each other (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes). Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Difficulty breathing
- Headache
- Congestion or runny nose
- Cough
- Fatigue
- Loss of taste or smell
- Nausea or vomiting
- Shortness of breath
- Muscle or body aches
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea

Recommendations:

1. Be watchful for symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 illness that may appear in your child during the next 14 days.
2. Take precautions to avoid illness, including:
  - a. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
  - b. Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others
  - c. Avoid close contact with people who are sick
  - d. Refrain from touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
  - e. Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue
  - f. Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects
  - g. Individuals at higher risk for severe COVID-19 illness, such as older adults or people who have chronic medical conditions like heart, lung, or kidney disease, should take actions to reduce your risk of exposure (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/need-extra-precautions/people-with-medical-conditions.html>)
