

Students of Rich Hill R-IV are held to high expectations to ensure they receive a quality education. The purpose of this policy is to ensure an appropriate pace is maintained for our virtual students and to outline the effect it will have on the student's grade if it is not maintained.

It is the expectation of virtual students to have completed a percentage of the coursework utilizing the following guidelines for a year long class.

End of 1st Quarter – 25% completed with course

End of 2nd Quarter – 50% completed with course and mid-term exam completed

End of 3rd Quarter – 75% completed with course

End of 4th Quarter – 100% completed with course and final exam completed

If the virtual student has met the above requirements, their grade from Acellus (or other virtual platform) will be utilized as their final grade.

If the virtual student has not met the requirements above, the student's grade will be docked. The formula to determine the student's grade is as follows:

$$\text{Final Grade} = \frac{\text{Percent completed of course}}{\text{Expected completion during grading period}} \times \text{Grade from virtual platform}$$

In addition, if a mid-term or final is expected to be completed and is not, an additional 10% will be docked off of the final grade.

Furthermore, attendance for A+ will also be docked using the following formula:

$$\text{Final Attendance} = \frac{\text{Percent completed of course}}{\text{Expected completion during grading period}}$$

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It is the expectation of virtual students to have completed a percentage of the coursework utilizing the following guidelines for a semester long course.

End of 1st Quarter enrolled– 50% completed with course

End of 2nd Quarter enrolled – 100% completed with course and final exam completed

If the virtual student has met the above requirements, their grade from Acellus (or other virtual platform) will be utilized as their final grade.

If the virtual student has not met the requirements above, the student's grade will be docked. The formula to determine the student's grade is as follows:

$$\text{Final Grade} = \frac{\text{Percent completed of course}}{\text{Expected completion during grading period}} \times \text{Grade from virtual platform}$$

In addition, if the final exam is expected to be completed and is not, an additional 10% will be docked off of the final grade.

Furthermore, attendance for A+ will also be docked using the following formula:

$$\text{Final Attendance} = \frac{\text{Percent completed of course}}{\text{Expected completion during grading period}}$$
