Dear Families,

Today Johnson-Brock School District received confirmation that an elementary teacher has tested positive for COVID-19. The Southeast District Health Department (SEDHD) was notified immediately regarding the positive test result.

Currently, Johnson-Brock School District and the SEDHD are working together to notify the families of students and any staff who may have had direct contact with the individual and to determine the best course of action. The course of action for this **and all future identified cases** will be based upon factors such as the length of contact, whether or not social distancing was feasible, and if masks were being worn by the individual, students, and staff. Please note, you will only be contacted by SEDHD if your child(ren) was defined as a close contact for the positive case and therefore needs to quarantine.

Johnson-Brock School District takes the health and safety of our students and staff very seriously and will continue to work with SEDHD to protect our students and staff. Keep your child at home if he/she has a fever greater than 100.4 degrees and/or is experiencing any of the following symptoms.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
